

Umno Receives Kadir's Resignation Letter

KUALA LUMPUR, March 25 (Bernama) -- Umno has received the letter of resignation from Tan Sri Abdul Kadir Sheikh Fadzir as an Umno member, said party secretary-general Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor today.

He said the party received the letter via e-mail and fax on the same day that Abdul Kadir made the announcement that he was withdrawing from Umno.

"We have received the letter and the management had accepted it," he told the media after launching a function here.

However, Tengku Adnan declined to comment further on the letter.

Abdul Kadir had announced his resignation as an Umno member on March 19. Earlier, he had relinquished his position as treasurer of the Kulim-Bandar Baharu Umno division in Kedah, his last post in the party.

Abdul Kadir, who was also a former Member of Parliament for Kulim-Bandar Baharu, was an Umno member for 56 years since joining the party in 1956 and throughout his membership, he had held several positions such as Umno Youth exco member, Kedah Umno Youth head, and Umno Supreme Council member.
