

**'Khalwat' Case PKR Leader, Woman To Give Statement To Religious Department

KUANTAN, Feb 26 (Bernama) -- A Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) leader has been asked to turn up at the Pahang Islamic Affairs Department (Jaip) tomorrow over a "khalwat" (close proximity) with a married woman at a hotel here yesterday.

Jaip deputy director Datuk Mohd Ghazali Abd Aziz said today the politician and the woman are required to give statements as part of the investigation into the case.

"It is the normal procedure for people involved in cases of this nature," he said.

Once the investigation has been completed, the papers would be submitted to the prosecution for further action, he added.

The PKR leader and the woman were caught by a JAIP enforcement team at about 3 am in a room of a hotel in Balok here.
