

Parking Lots For Civil Servants At Government Buildings To Be Discussed In Cabinet - Nong Chik

PUTRAJAYA, Feb 26 (Bernama) -- The lack of parking lots allocated for civil servants who are Grade 54 and below, at government buildings, is expected to be discussed in the next cabinet meeting.

Federal Territories and Urban Well-Being Minister Datuk Raja Nong Chik Raja Zainal Abidin said the matter would also be discussed with Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Mohd Sidek Hassan.

Nong Chik who spoke to reporters after a Walk About and Meet the People Session at Presint 8 here today said a majority of civil servants used their own transport compared with those using public transport and that contributed to traffic congestion and lack of parking space at government buildings.

Putrajaya Member of Parliament Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor had during his speech urged the government to consider the request for parking lots at government buildings, by civil servants who belong to Grade 54 and below.

Nong Chik also urged civil servants to use the bus service provided by Perbadanan Putrajaya to commute to their office, to avoid traffic congestion and parking problems in Putrajaya.
