

Wee Chooses To Forgive Attackers At Rally

KUALA LUMPUR, March 26 (Bernama) -- Deputy Education Minister Datuk Dr Wee Ka Siong has chosen to forgive his attackers at the Chinese education rally yesterday in Kajang.

"(They can) Do what they like. I've chosen to forgive them. I'm prepared for the worst. I've the guts to listen to them, that's all," he told reporters when asked if he would lodge a police report over the incident.

Wee, who is also MCA Youth chief, said he refused to politicise the issue further.

"If I wanted to politicise it, I could have had another round of police reports and press conferences. I don't even want to talk about it," he added.

News portals reported that Wee was chased out of the rally organised by the United Chinese School Committees Association (Dong Zong) which protested over the lack of Chinese school teachers.
