

2,000 Visitors Expected To Attend 1Malaysia Unity Programme

GEORGE TOWN, March 27 (Bernama) -- About 2,000 visitors are expected to attend the Timur Laut 1Malaysia Unity Programme at Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Tamil (SJKT) Jalan Sungai, Sungai Pinang here on April 28.
