

Memo On Minimum Wage For Sabah Private Sector Handed Over To Deputy Minister

KOTA KINABALU, March 27 (Bernama) -- A memorandum on the minimum salary proposal for private sector employees in Sabah has been handed over to Deputy Human Resources Minister Datuk Maznah Mazlan, the State Legislative Assembly was told today.

Assistant Minister of Resource and Information Technology Development Datuk Jainab Ahmad Ayid said the memorandum was following a discussion between the Sabah Manpower Department, Federation of Sabah Manufacturers and employer's associations in the state.

"The Sabah Manpower Department has also carried out numerous efforts in support of the minimum wage proposal.

"The department became the wage consultation secretariat for the National Wage Consultation Technical Committee and the related parties in Kota Kinabalu, Sandakan and Tawau in August last year," she said in reply to a question from Au Kam Wah (BN-Elopura) during question time.

Jainab said the department had also held meetings with stakeholders such as worker's unions and employers to obtain feedback on the proposal.
