

Opposition Pact To Meet On Tuesday To Decide On A Simultaneous General Election

MELAKA, March 8 (Bernama) -- Leaders in the opposition pact will meet on Tuesday (March 13) to decide whether to hold the election in states under control simultaneously for the general election.

DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng said the meeting would be held in Kuala Lumpur.

He said the announcement by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak on the salary adjustments for the 1.3 million civil servants today was a sign that the general election would be soon.

It is a sign that the general election is near, perhaps after the installation of the Yang diPertuan Agong on April 12 or possibly in May, he told reporters after attending the closing of the forum for Indonesia-Malaysia-Thailand growth triangle (IMT-GT) Chief Ministers and Governors at a hotel here Thursday.
