

**PSD To Meet Next Week To Discuss SBPA Issue**

PUTRAJAYA, March 9 (Bernama) -- The Public Service Department (PSD) is scheduled to meet as early as next week to discuss whether there are civil servants or pensioners who have received their salary or pension according to the Civil Service New Remuneration Scheme (SBPA), which was cancelled by the government.

A PSD source, when contacted by Bernama, said the meeting was expected to be attended by representatives from the relevant ministries, departments and agencies who would study the matter and resolve the issue.

If there were such cases, the source said, the meeting would find an appropriate mechanism to resolve them.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Abdul Razak Thursday announced the cancellation of the SBPA and reverted to an improved Malaysian Remuneration System (SSM).

The government had decided on Jan 12 that the SPBA, which should have been implemented on Jan 1, be reviewed following dissatisfaction from civil servants.

A task force chaired by former PSD director-general Tan Sri Ismail Adam was later set up and given three months to scrutinise all the complaints and feedback that had been received. It had been given the task to submit a proposal to the government to resolve the matter.
