HARD WORKER: Minister's credibility showed in the work he had done for the party

KOTA BARU: GUA Musang member of parliament Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah has praised International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed for being a great leader who had managed to regain support from the party's members in Kelantan.

Describing him as a hardworking person, Tengku Razaleigh said Mustapa's credibility showed in the work he had done for the party.

However, the Gua Musang Umno chief said Mustapa's efforts would not have been successful without cooperation from the leadership and the grassroots.

"I see he (Mustapa) and his team have worked hard and have made a lot of effort to gain the support of the people to win back Kelantan.

"This is a good sign and showed that Umno has a chance in the coming general election."

He was speaking after holding a briefing and launching the state-level Angkatan Amanah Merdeka here on Tuesday.

In another development, Tengku Razaleigh said Umno in Gua Musang had a chance to retain the seat in the coming election.

"I am confident that the parliamentary constituency seat that I head will remain unchanged even though there might be competition," said the longest-serving MP in the country.

On a report that Amanah would attend the Bersih 3.0 gathering scheduled on April 28, Tengku Razaleigh, who is Amanah president, denied that the movement would take part in the event.

"Amanah is willing to cooperate with any organisation in the country, but will not involve in gathering like Bersih 3.0, as it is not a registered movement like us," he said.
