

**Bank Negara to probe alleged violations by PKR's Rafizi**

KUALA LUMPUR: Bank Negara has received details of 21 alleged violations of the Banking and Financial Institutions Act by PKR strategy director Rafizi Ramli relating to the National Feedlot Corporation.

NFCorp chairman Datuk Seri Mohamad Salleh Ismail met the central bank's investigations unit head Mazlan Ahmad and other officials on the alleged violations here yesterday.

He was accompanied by NFCorp chief executive officer Wan Shahinur Izmir, lawyers Datuk Seri Shafee Abdullah and Wan Shahrizal Wan Ladin and two other members of his legal team.

After the meeting, Mohamad Salleh reiterated that Rafizi had distributed to the media for public display the private and confidential banking details as well as credit ratings of the corporation and its related companies.

Mohamad Salleh said NFCorp lodged a formal complaint to the particular bank last March 30.

However, he added that despite the two sent letters by the corporation's lawyers, the bank had failed to comply with the demands of the companies and directors.

Mazlan said after the meeting that Bank Negara would look into the matter.
