

Shahrizat's suit against PKR leaders fixed for Aug 6

KUALA LUMPUR: The RM100mil suit by Datuk Seri Shahrizat Abdul Jalil against two PKR leaders has been set for Aug 6.

High Court judge Justice Vazeer Alam Mydin Meera said the trial date should be set immediately as cases filed in the new civil courts had to be settled within nine months.

He set Aug 6 for the trial to start and May 17 for case management.

The court ordered the plaintiff to file their application for amendments within one week from today.

Earlier, Shahrizat's counsel Datuk Ahmad Redza Abdullah applied to amend her statement of claim in the suit against PKR director of strategy Mohd Rafizi Ramli and its Wanita chief Zuraida Kamaruddin.

On Jan 19, Shahrizat filed the suit against Mohd Rafizi and Zuraida over allegations connected to the National Feedlot Corporation (NFC) issue.

Shahrizat is seeking RM50mil as general damages and another RM50mil as aggravated and exemplary damages.

On March 8, Rafizi filed a counter-claim claiming Shahrizat had launched a personal attack on him while delivering a speech at the Wanita Umno general assembly on Nov 30.

He claimed that her words, which were published and repeated in the print and online media, implied that he was dishonest, disloyal and a traitor to the Malay race and Islam.
