

Malaysia, Britain target RM38bil in trade by 2016

PUTRAJAYA: Malaysia and Britain have set a target of £8bil (RM38bil) in bilateral trade by 2016.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said the economic ministers of both countries have been tasked with achieving the target.

His counterpart David Cameron said the target was achievable as both countries enjoyed strong bilateral relationships.

Trade was among the areas discussed by both leaders in their meeting at Seri Perdana Thursday.

Other areas are political and diplomatic relations, education and training, science and technology and environment, and defence and security.

Both leaders made a joint statement on the matters after the meeting.
