

PAS: We are better and stronger than PKR

KUALA TERENGGANU: PAS has belittled its Pakatan Rakyat partner PKR, saying it is a "better and stronger" party in the general election.

PAS Education Bureau chairman Datuk Abu Bakar Chik said PAS was stronger than PKR "anywhere in the country."

Abu Bakar, the party's former Terengganu commissioner, said PAS would most probably allow PKR to contest a maximum of seven seats - five state and two parliament.

He was commenting on an earlier statement by the state PKR that it would be contesting 11 state and three parliament seats in the general election.

"It is a fact that PAS is stronger than PKR. However, we still respect them as they are our coalition partner.

"We will make the decision on seat allocations and PKR has to bear the risk," he told a press conference.

"I feel the party is hesitant to let PKR contest 11 state seats and three parliament seats. Five state seats and two parliament is most ideal."

He said PAS's leadership would make the final decision and the final list was with president Datuk Seri Hadi Awang.
