

Laman Kasih scheme to help the disabled in agriculture

PUTRAJAYA: Disabled people in Selangor can now achieve financial independence in the agriculture sector – thanks to a special programme called *Laman Kasih*.

The project is spearheaded by a non-profit organisation called Kasih, short for Badan Amal dan Kasih Negeri Selangor.

The movement is anchored by spouses of current and former Selangor Barisan Nasional leaders.

A company by the name of Waiz K Bio-Organics will conduct intensive training for the disabled enrolled in the programme on how to operate a medium-scale fertigation system, said Kasih president Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor.

“Thirty disabled people from Selangor Traders with Disabilities Association will receive fertigation kits to kickstart their projects.

“In the next six to 10 months, these pioneers will become mentors who will train other disabled people,” the Prime Minister’s wife said when launching the Kasih fourth annual general meeting at Wisma Tani here yesterday.
