

Muhyiddin: BN the solution to Kelantan's woes

BACHOK: Barisan Nasional is the solution to all the woes faced by the people of Kelantan, said Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin.

The Deputy Prime Minister said Barisan, under the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, could bring about changes and development that were lacking in the state, if it were given the opportunity to lead.

He said the PAS-led state government had ruled for more than 20 years but had failed to provide even basic necessities to the people, including clean water supply.

The Deputy Prime Minister, who is in Kelantan for a one-day visit, earlier went for a walkabout at the market in Jelawat.

He is also scheduled to meet government retirees for lunch and attend a gathering with ulama and Rela members in Tumpat.
