

**Court wants Home Minister's stand on Bersih**

KUALA LUMPUR: The High Court has asked the Home Minister to file an affidavit clarifying his position on the Bersih 2.0 movement by May 10.

Lawyer Aston Paiva, representing Bersih, told reporters that Justice Datuk Rohana Yusof had taken notice of Bersih's recent activity, and needed to confirm the Minister's position on the movement before making a decision.

Bersih 2.0 co-chairman Datuk S. Ambiga had filed a suit challenging a ban on Bersih 2.0 by the government which declared the movement an 'illegal organisation'.

Aston said in Justice Rohana's view, the rally seemed to have been banned, but the Home Minister's conduct seemed to suggest otherwise.

He added that Justice Rohana was also concerned about the main application whether Bersih should have been banned, and said she needed to know the Minister's stand to properly evaluate all the facts.
