

**1Malaysia breakfast in SibU**

SIBU: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said his experience of having breakfast with people from different races at the SibU Central Market was reflective of his 1Malaysia concept.

"Sitting at the same table with me were two Chinese, a Malay, a Melanau and an Iban," Najib said at the opening of SJK Thai Kwang.

He said this showed that Malaysian society was a peaceful and harmonious one where people from different races could live and work together.

Najib stressed that Malaysia could only become a fully developed nation if the country had peace and harmony.

"Under Barisan Nasional at the state and federal levels, we promise to be moderate, fair and inclusive to all the people," he said, adding that no country in the world was perfect.

He advised the people to treasure the existing peace and harmony and not gamble away the future built over the years.

"Do not take our success for granted as we want to be more successful," Najib stressed.

He said Malaysia had adequate resources for every one and the Government would fulfil its promises to the people.

Najib said the promise on the implementation of first phase of the flood mitigation project costing almost RM250mil in SibU had been completed while phase two costing RM50mil would begin next month.
