NIBONG TEBAL: A large group of Indians gathered at Medan Selera Jawi here in a show of support for Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak for fulfilling pledges made to the community.

Carrying banners reflecting their support for the Prime Minister, the group also condemned the opposition for failing to live up to promises made during the last general election.

The group comprised members from the PPP, Indian Progressive Front (IPF) and several NGOs.
