

**Najib's Commitment, Sincerity Can Win People's Support - Ko Youn

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 18 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) can win more seats in the next general election as the people see the commitment and sincerity of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak in implementing the transformation programmes, said Gerakan deputy president Chang Ko Youn.

He said the BN has responded positively to the needs and demands of the people, particularly with regard to the issues of corruption, abuse of power and the government delivery system.

"After the 2008 general election, the BN government has been taking effective measures, including the Government Transformation Programme, the Economic Transformation Programme and the Political Transformation Programme.

"The abolition of restrictive laws, including the Internal Security Act (ISA), reforming the judiciary and forming the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) and the amendment to the University and University Colleges Act 1971 (UCCA) show the sincerity of the government," he said at the "Malaysian Chinese at the Political Crossroad" conference here Saturday.
