

Najib To Visit Kelantan On Tuesday

MACHANG, Jan 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is due in Kelantan on Tuesday for a visit, state Umno chief Datuk Mustapa Mohamed said.

Among others, Najib is scheduled to meet state Barisan Nasional (BN) leaders and commission 15 vans for the state Wanita Umno's Skudat Sayang, he said after declaring open the BN operations room here.

He also said that the state Umno was planning a programme for the Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin's visit to the state next month.

"Their presence in the state will spur the state BN to work harder to win back Kelantan," he said, adding that the wind of change was becoming evident in the state with many PAS supporters and members joining Umno, including 73 people from Temangan who handed over their membership application forms to Mustapa.

Che Mustapha @ Che Pa Said, who spoke on behalf of the group, said they had grown tired of the attitude of PAS leaders whom they said had failed to keep their promises.
