

**PM Meets Pahang BN Leaders**

KUANTAN, Jan 21 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak Saturday met 300 Pahang Barisan Nasional (BN) leaders in which they pledged loyalty and allegiance to Najib who is Umno president and BN chairman.

The one-hour closed-door meeting took place at the Pahang Foundation building in conjunction with Najib's visit to the state.
