

**Two Families Delighted Over Prime Minister's Visit

SITIAWAN, Jan 28 (Bernama) -- Two families were overwhelmed over Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor's visit to their houses in Taman Sepakat here Saturday night.

The prime minister and his wife, who were greeted on arrival at 8.30pm by about 300 residents of Taman Sepakat, spent about 30 minutes at both houses.

Farmer Tan Kee Siew, 40, and his wife, Chong Lee Chuan, 38, presented Najib with a basket of papayas and seedless guava cultivated by him.

Kee Siew's father, Tan Sing Leng, 63, said the family were surprised when told about Najib's intended visit one week ago although at first they thought it was a prank.

"I was losing sleep over the visit," he said, adding that his son and his daughter prepared a greeting card for Najib and gave it to him during the visit.

For odd-job worker Ling Tai Yew, 52, and his family, Najib and Rosmah's visit to their house was like a dream come true.

"My family and I were very happy as we got to shake hands with the prime minister and his wife," said Ling, who later garlanded Najib.

Najib and Rosmah later left for the national-level Chinese New Year open house at the Sitiawan airfield.

They were accompanied by Information Communications and Culture Minister Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim, Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir, Transport Minister Datuk Seri Kong Cho Ha and MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Chua Soi Lek.
