

**Call For An Immediate Stop To Sensitive Statements On Religion**

PUTRAJAYA, April 3 (Bernama) -- The Committee to Promote Understanding and Harmony Among Religious Followers (JKMPKA) today urged all parties to immediately stop issuing sensitive statements on religion to preserve the existing inter-faith harmony in the country.

National Unity and Integration Department director-general Datuk Azman Amin Hassan, who is also JKMPKA chairman, said such irresponsible acts could create misunderstanding.

All parties must be responsible in ensuring the good relations among the followers of various religions is preserved and strengthened by adhering to existing laws, he said in a statement today after chairing a JKMPKA meeting here.

"JKMPKA urges that police reports be lodged (if such statements are made) so that investigations can be carried out to take action according to the provisions of law if," he said.

Meanwhile, Azman said the meeting today was attended by the Working Committee on Understanding Issues Among Religious Followers, Working Committee on Mediation Among Religious Followers and the Joint Working Committee Between Government and Community Leaders to draw up programmes for implementation this year.
