

Kelantan Government To Consider Giving Land To Retired Army Personnel

KOTA BAHARU, April 4 (Bernama) -- The Kelantan state government has formed a committee to give at least 0.809 hectare of land to eligible ex-army personnel who are born in the state.

State housing, works, utilities and environment committee chairman, Datuk Md Anizam Abd Rahman said the move was in line with the order by the Armed Forces Council that each army retiree was eligible to receive land.

"However, the committee which will be headed by me and assisted by the State Human Development, Youth, Sports and Non-Governmental Organisations Committee chairman, Datuk Abdul Fatah Mahmood will identify certain criteria before implementing the provision for land.

"The committee will identify the actual number of army retirees who will be awarded land, based on criteria to be determined," he told reporters after a state exco meeting here Wednesday.
