

SKVC Seeks Malaysian Government's Intervention In Convicted Malaysian Drug Trafficker's Case

SINGAPORE, April 5 (Bernama) -- The organisers of the Save Vui Kong Campaign (SKVC) Thursday urged the Malaysia government to intervene to save Yong Vui Kong, a convicted drug trafficker after failing in its bid to get Singapore's Court of Appeal to reopen his case and set aside his death sentence.

In a statement, SKVC coordinator Ngeow Chow Ying: " We urge the government to intervene in whatever manner to save this young Malaysian from suffering death, including bringing the matter to the International Court of Justice."

Ngeow said SKVC regretted that the court had dismissed Yong's application to review his conviction on the grounds of unequal treatment.
