

Three MPs Given Marching Orders Today

KUALA LUMPUR, April 5 (Bernama) -- Three MPs were given the marching orders by Dewan Rakyat Deputy Speaker Datuk Ronald Kiandee today for not behaving with decorum in the august house.

They were N.Gobalakrishnan (Bebas-Padang Serai), Datuk Saifuddin Nasution (PKR-Machang) and Datuk Tajuddin Abdul Rahman (BN-Pasir Salak).

All three were told to leave when the Supplementary Supply Bill (2011) 2012 was being debated and they no longer got to participate in the debates for the rest of today's sitting.

On Tuesday, three opposition MPs were also ordered to leave the House by Dewan Rakyat Speaker Tan Sri Pandikar Amin Mulia after causing chaos in the House when their requests to include a minority report together with the report by the Parliamentary Select Committee for Electoral Reform was denied by the Speaker.
