

**No Need To Hold Bersih 3.0 Rally, Says Sarawak BN Youth Chief**

KUCHING, April 7 (Bernama) -- There is no need for the Bersih 3.0 rally planned to be held on April 28, said Sarawak Assistant Minister for Science, Technology and Innovation Datuk Fadillah Yusof.

Fadillah, who is also Sarawak Barisan Nasional Youth chief, said this was because a Parliamentary Select Committee was set up to look into electoral reform in the country.

Holding the rally would only earn the ire of the people and give a negative picture of the political situation in the country to the outside world, he told reporters after closing a sepak takraw event in Kampung No 3 here today.

The PSC's report on electoral reform, which had 22 recommendations, was passed by the Dewan Rakyat this week.

However, Bersih, a movement calling for electoral reform expressed unhappiness with the report and is planning to hold rallies throughout the country on April 28 to voice its objections.
