

GTP In Kelantan Will Be More Comprehensive If BN Rules - Fatmi

KOTA BAHARU, April 9 (Bernama) -- The Government Transformation Programme (GTP) will be comprehensively enjoyed by the people of Kelantan if Barisan Nasional (BN) recaptures the state in the next general election, said the Prime Minister's political secretary Datuk Mohd Fatmi Che Salleh.

Fatmi, who is also Kota Baharu Umno chief, said if BN were to rule in Kelantan, all programmes identified under GTP would be implemented including the issue of land.

"At the moment, all GTP programmes are going on smoothly and have been well received by the people of Kelantan, nonetheless if they were to choose BN in the coming general election, the success of GTP will be more comprehensively felt.

"As an example, the People's Housing Project which is difficult to be implemented by the federal government as the issue of land is a state matter... can be overcome," he told reporters after presenting the 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) to 2,000 residents of the Kota Baharu Parliamentary constituency here Monday.

Mohd Fatmi added that many people in Kelantan wanted to own PPR houses but failed to do so because the state government did not implement the project since 1990.
