

Lynas Has Proposed To Recycle Waste For Commercial Purposes - Ongkili

KUALA LUMPUR, April 10 (Bernama) -- Lynas Corporation Ltd (Lynas) has proposed to recycle waste from its rare earth factory in Pahang to enable such waste to be reused commercially.

Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Datuk Seri Dr Maximus Ongkili said to realise the proposal, Lynas would carry out a comprehensive research and development (R&D) study to ensure the waste could benefit society.

"If the R&D fails, the waste would be placed at a permanent dump facility. In a worst case scenario, Lynas has issued a letter of undertaking by agreeing to take back the waste to the original source," he said in a written answer to a question from Lim Guan Eng (DAP-Bagan) at Dewan Rakyat here, Tuesday.
