

Security Offences Bill Tabled For The First Time In Dewan Rakyat

KUALA LUMPUR, April 10 (Bernama) -- The Security Offences (Special Measures) Bill 2012, to replace the Internal Security Act 1960, was tabled for the first time in the Dewan Rakyat today.

The bill was tabled for its first reading by Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Nazri Aziz.

He also proposed the tabling of the bill for the second reading during the current meeting.

Speaker Tan Sri Pandikar Amin Mulia said the bill would be debated on Monday.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak in conjunction with Malaysia Day celebration on Sept 15 last year announced the repeal of ISA, and the creation of a new act in its place.
