

**Ministry Seeks Public Cooperation To Expose Sale Of Recycled Cooking Oil**

KUALA LUMPUR, March 10 (Bernama) -- The Health Ministry is seeking public cooperation to expose the names of individuals or factories involved in selling recycled cooking oil in the local market.

Its minister, Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai, said the sale of recycled cooking oil was an offence under the Food Act 1983 and the ministry was in the midst of investigating and identifying the culprits.

He said the ministry had also conducted random monitoring activities on retail outlets and cooking oil manufacturing plants nationwide.

"So far, 22 cooking oil manufacturing plants nationwide have been identified to have stocked up recycled cooking oil, but they said they only use it in the biodiesel and soap production process."
