

Putrajaya Retains 40 Per Cent Of Land Use For Green Belt

PUTRAJAYA, April 13 (Bernama) -- Forty per cent of land use in Putrajaya will be retained for forest, parks, lakes and public landscapes to pave the way for the administrative capital to become a model green city, said Putrajaya Corporation president Tan Sri Samsudin Osman.

He said to date, about 650,000 trees had been planted in Putrajaya while one million plants and trees had been targeted to be planted in the next few years.

"The uniqueness of Putrajaya besides building and infrastructure designs is its green belt, for which a huge investment from the government should not be taken lightly," he said at the signing ceremony of a memorandum of understanding (MoU) between Forest Research Institute of Malaysia (FRIM) and Putrajaya Corporation, here Friday.
