

Uphold Constitutional Monarchy, Muslims Urged

KUALA LUMPUR, April 13 (Bernama) -- Muslims have been urged to uphold the constitutional monarchy to ensure that the spread of Islamic teachings and Muslim well-being are protected from any form of intrusion.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Jamil Khir Baharom said as the axis of the institution, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong would continue to ensure that the Muslim unity and the sanctity of Islam would continue to be protected.

"The pulpit calls on Muslims to avoid from getting involved in any action that could undermine or discredit the rulers institution and question provisions enshrined in the constitution, including the sanctity of Islam as the official religion of the country.

"If Muslims lose their integrity and dignity, and allowed themselves to be manipulated by others, they will eventually be saddled with ill-fate and humiliated in their homeland," said when delivering the Friday prayer's special sermon at the National Mosque special here today.

The sermon entitled "His Majesty the Pillar of Muslim Unity" was delivered to mark the coronation of the Sultan of Kedah Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'azam Shah as the 14th Yang di-Pertuan Agong on Wednesday.
