

Pahang Perkasa Lodges Police Report On Alleged Show Of Disrespect For Royalty

KUANTAN, April 16 (Bernama) -- The Pahang chapter of the Malay right-wing group Perkasa today lodged a police report over an allegation of some opposition leaders ridiculing the Malay rulers during the installation ceremony of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah at Istana Negara last April 11.

Its information chief, Muhammad Faiz Hassim, said the report was lodged to enable the police to investigate the matter and for action to be taken against those who showed disrespect for the royal institution as a lesson to others.

"The report is lodged based on a newspaper report on April 13 concerning an allegation by a medical officer on the insolent behaviour of some opposition leaders at the function," he told reporters when met in the compound of the Kuantan district police headquarters here.

He said the matter should be viewed seriously by all quarters to preserve the sovereignty of the royal institution.
