

**Rosnah Wants Firm Action Against Elected Representatives Who Ridicule Malay Rulers**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 19 (Bernama) -- Puteri Umno chief Datuk Rosnah Abdul Rashid Shirlin welcomed calls by various quarters for stern action to be taken by the Home Ministry against elected representatives who ridiculed the Malay rulers.

She said this in response to an allegation that some members of parliament from the opposition parties had shown lack of respect to the royal institution during the installation ceremony of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong recently.

She said it showed that the opposition leaders had no respect for the royal institution and worst, what their action was supported by Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim.

The show of support by the opposition leaders to the action of their colleagues during the Agong's installation ceremony was an embarrassment to the Malays and Malaysians, she said in a statement here today.

Abdul Khalid, in a statement issued last Tuesday, described the issue as "petty" and was purposely blown out of proportion for political purposes.

He also said that he was prepared to have an audience with the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah to explain the matter.
