

**BN Government Supports Growth Of Sabah's Chinese Community - Musa

SANDAKAN, April 20 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) government will continue to support the growth of the Chinese community in Sabah, said Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman.

He said the Federal Government had, in the 2012 Budget, announced a RM100 million allocation for Chinese schools, proving that the government was fair to all communities.

"Likewise, the Sabah Government will continue to disburse financial aid to Chinese schools and temples, a commitment we have undertaken for many years now.

"Last year alone, the state government gave out over RM30 million for this purpose," he said at the 1Malaysia meet-the-people session in the Sandakan and Batu Sapi parliamentary constituencies which was officiated by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak here Friday night.

Musa said credit must be given where it was due, and that it was important not to be misled or manipulated by dirty tactics of the opposition which belittled the BN government's achievements.
