

**Dewan Rakyat Extends Session To Early Morning**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 20 (Bernama) -- The Dewan Rakyat sitting yesterday lasted until the early hours of Friday morning to allow for all matters at hand to be resolved.

It is said this was the first time parliament faced such a situation after the Kelantan Emergency Ordinance was debated in 1977.

The sitting was adjourned at 3.22am today after 22 days in session.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Mohamed Nazri Abdul Aziz said the Standing Order 90(2) was used to suspend Standing Order 12 which states that all matters must be completed in the same day.

"This has never happened since I've been involved in the Parliament," he told reporters at the Parliament lobby, here today.

Mohamed Nazri tabled the motion last night while the Dewan Rakyat was debating the Capital Markets and Services (Amendment) Bill 2012 for the second reading.
