

Home Ministry Denies Issuing Special Approval Letter For 6P Programme

PUTRAJAYA, March 7 (Bernama) -- The home ministry has denied an allegation on the existence of a special approval letter signed by minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein to legalise immigrant workers under the 6P legalisation programme.

This follows a number of reports received, that the letter was used by certain parties in Cameron Highlands to collect money from employers, particularly tea and vegetable plantation owners in the area.

In a statement here Wednesday, ministry secretary-general Tan Sri Mahmood Adam said:

"The approval for the 6P legalisation programme can only be issued by regulatory agencies, upon completion of all prescribed procedures at nine one-stop centres which currently operate until April 10.
