

Selangor Government Only Putting On Show On Sand Mining Scandal

KUALA LUMPUR, March 7 (Bernama) -- The Selangor government is only putting on a show by asking its Select Committee on Competency, Accountability and Transparency (Selcat) to investigate into the state's sand mining scandal, said Selangor MCA.

Its State Liaison Committee secretary Wong Koon Mun said Selcat had no authority and the investigation into the scandal would not solve the problem.

"As the state government is unable to solve the sand theft issue, they are only putting on a show by asking Selcat, which has no authority, to investigate so that people will think that they are taking this issue seriously.

"Besides that, they have also pushed the responsibility to the witness by claiming that he did not attend (the hearing today) and had refused to assist the Selcat hearing, and later use the excuse that they have no evidence as an attempt to cover up the matter," he said in a statement, here, today.

The Kuala Kubu Baru assemblyman also said that the state government did not investigate the issue even after they received complaints.
