

NGOs: Probe Anwar and his billions

KUALA LUMPUR: Representatives of 30 non-governmental organisations (NGOs) yesterday lodged separate reports urging police to investigate allegations that Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim controlled 20 master accounts worth RM3 billion.

The NGOs included Pertubuhan Pribumi Perkasa Malaysia, Pertubuhan Kebajikan and Dakwah Islamiah Malaysia, Ex-Policemen's Association and other organisations from the Gombak district.

They lodged the reports at the Gombak police station after holding a 15-minute peaceful demonstration after Friday prayers.

The demonstration was aimed at urging the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission, police, Home Ministry and Inland Revenue Board to initiate investigations.

Group spokesman Datuk Dr Rahman Ismail said the government should not be silent on the matter as the people would lose faith.

The issue resurfaced after former Bank Negara Malaysia assistant governor Datuk Abdul Murad Khalid claimed that Anwar owned 20 master accounts worth RM3 billion.
