

**Dr M says has little knowledge on illegal migrants but willing to testify in RCI**

CYBERJAYA: Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad is prepared to testify at the Royal Commission of Inquiry (RCI) to investigate problems related to illegal immigrants in Sabah.

He said there were circumstances in the past which resulted in the mass movement of people between the Philippines and Sabah that were difficult to monitor.

He said all this happened at the time when the government's ability to monitor the mass movement of people from the Philippines was quite limited.

"I don't know what I can testify to. If I have any knowledge, I am quite willing," he told reporters at a press conference for the launching the KRU Academy here yesterday.

Dr Mahathir was asked if he would testify before the RCI as it was during his leadership that there was an influx of illegal immigrants in Sabah.

"I can go to the courts to tell them whatever I know but I must admit that I don't know very much," he quipped.

On June 1, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak announced the setting up of the RCI.
