

**PM: BN govt won't make impossible promises**

PUTRAJAYA: The Barisan Nasional government will not make sweet promises that are impossible to fulfil, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said.

He said the Government could not promise that the price of petrol could be reduced in the near future.

"The Government sets aside RM2bil every month as petrol subsidy but there are people who promise to reduce the price if they are in power.

"They also promise to abolish toll and set the minimum wage at RM4,000.

"We don't have to be intellectuals to realise that all these promises are impossible," he told the monthly gathering of the Prime Minister's Department here Monday.

Najib said these people did not care about the country's future.

"All they have in mind is the chair behind me ... to sit on my chair," he said.
