

BN members have to play as a team, says Najib

KUANTAN: Using sports as an analogy, Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak urged those aspiring to be Barisan Nasional candidates not to be disheartened if they were not picked to contest in the general election.

The Prime Minister said politicians should have sportsmanship or they would not obtain satisfaction from "the game".

"It does not matter who among us wins as long as the party comes out the champion at the end of the game," the Barisan chairman told the party's elected representatives at a dinner here yesterday.

Najib said no one could work in isolation in politics.

Najib, who had earlier witnessed his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor and wives of the other Barisan representatives compete in a badminton championship, said their role was equally important as they had an impact on their husbands.

"When people come knocking on our doors, our wives cannot greet them with a sour face as this will affect our standing among constituents," he quipped.
