

**Tengku Adnan: 66th Umno anniversary celebration to be special**

PETALING JAYA: It will be a celebration like no other as Umno celebrates its 66th anniversary tomorrow.

The celebration, which is usually serious and solemn, will have a carnival feel to it as a list of programmes have been lined up to bring Umno closer to the people.

Umno secretary-general Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Mansor said the party wanted this celebration to be "special" not only for its members but also for the public.

Umno president and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will lead the celebration and his speech is much awaited by all with the general election looming.

"Component party leaders and representatives would be joining us in the celebration. This is a testament of our comradeship and the spirit of togetherness that we share in the coalition," Tengku Adnan added.

A full-dress rehearsal was held last night to ensure everything would run smoothly and without glitches.

Apart from the main celebration, concerts featuring popular artistes and expositions showcasing Umno and its three wings and government agencies would be held.

There will also be mini clinics to carry out health screening and street soccer, skateboard, paintball competitions for the public to participate and the Barisan Nasional Youth Job Fair is back due to popular demand
