

DPM tells Guan Eng to take responsibility for hillslope development

GEORGETOWN: Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said on Saturday that Penang Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng had to take responsibility for hillslope development in the state which has affected the environment.
