

**BN Continues Practising Good Teamwork And Working Hard - Tun Abdullah

PUTRAJAYA, Oct 19 (Bernama) -- Umno and other component parties in Barisan Nasional (BN) will continue practising the concept of teamwork and working hard to get the mandate to continue governing the country, former Prime Minister Tun Abdullah Ahmad Badawi said.

In fact, he said BN had been working harder than ever and had proved to the people that it was the only coalition that could bring positive changes to the people and the country.

Although BN did not have a two-thirds majority in Parliament after the last general election, it will not hamper the party from bringing changes and development to the country, he said.
