

PM To Take Calls To Mark Opening Of PAKAR

SHAH ALAM, May 2 (Bernama) - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will take calls made to Barisan Nasional People's Service Centre (PAKAR) at Selangor Umno building here on May 10.

Selangor BN coordinator Datuk Seri Mohd Zin Mohamed said Najib will handle three callers to the PAKAR line after the centre's opening ceremony that day.

"The lucky callers will interact with the prime minister and will receive special gifts from PAKAR," he told a press conference here Wednesday.

PAKAR which began operation on April 9 acts as the party's medium of communication and services to the people via the line 1-300-22-2626.

The public can make complaints on elected representatives in their areas and problems on waste management, pose questions on Bantuan Rakyat 1Malaysia (BR1M) programme and get party information.

The reports and complaints received are directly sent to all Selangor state assembly and parliamentary constituency service centres for immediate action.

Mohd Zin said until April 30, Pakar has received 1,138 calls of which 400 were related to garbage collection, roads, street lighting and overgrown grass.
