

Muhyiddin Spends Time Attending 'Kenduri'

MUAR, May 4 (Bernama) -- Despite his busy schedule, Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin managed to spare over an hour to attend a feast in Kampung Durian Chondong Bukit, Bukit Serampang here Friday.

At the function, Muhyiddin who also opened the kampung's Bestari Hall was feted to the local favourite, white rice with fresh water fish curry, which is also a very popular dish in the rural areas of the Muar, Ledang and Segamat districts.

Muhyiddin also heard out the problems of the residents including the threat some 60 fish traps placed along Sungai Muar from Segamat to Bukit Kepong posed to fishermen who depended on the river for their livelihood.

The village's headman Anuar Hamzah told Bernama that the deputy prime minister was very concerned about the matter and promised to help them solve the problem.

Muhyiddin, who is also the MP for Pagoh, had earlier performed the Friday prayers at the village's mosque.
