

Najib Goes On A Walkabout At Batu Pahat Market

BATU PAHAT, April 7 (Bernama) -- The atmosphere at Jalan Ibrahim here was filled with excitement when Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak came to visit the place today.

Arriving at about 9.15am, Najib had a simple breakfast of "kopi o", nasi lemak and "roti bakar" at Chop Tong Ah coffee shop.

He was accompanied by among others MCA president Datuk Seri Chua Soi Lek, Johor Menteri Besar Datuk Abdul Ghani Othman, Batu Pahat Member of Parliament Dr Puad Zakarshi, Parit Sulong Member of Parliament Datuk Noraini Ahmad and Minister of Domestic Trade, Cooperative and Consumerism Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob.

Members of the public who turned up at the market literally pushed one another to shake hands, taking photographs with their handphones or just to take a glimpse of Najib.

He also visited several shops in the vicinity. After spending 45 minutes visiting the area, Najib left for the national-level "Jelajah Janji Ditepati" program at Batu Pahat Stadium.
