

**Durian Runtuh A Reward For Settlers' Hard Work And Sacrifices - Isa Samad

KUALA LUMPUR, April 14 (Bernama) -- The opposition's attempts to disparage the government's promise to provide a windfall to Felda settlers for the listing of Felda Global Ventures Holdings (FGVH) are deemed to insult the settlers' sacrifices.

Felda chairman Tan Sri Isa Abdul Samad said the windfall was a deserved reward for the settlers' support, hard work and dedication to Felda's land development programme over many decades.

"Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has repeatedly promised that the government will give a "durian runtuh" (windfall) payout to all Felda settlers in the lead-up to FGVH's planned listing.

"The government has also repeatedly stated that the money to be utilised for the payout will be from Felda's own funds and not from the Treasury," he said in a statement, here, Saturday.
